


Starting NOW, families of ACES/TAS/WAHS students will have access to vaccines through the following channels



Option #1 – LAUSD

Option #2 – L.A. County

Right now, L.A. County residents who are 50 and older are eligible to receive a vaccine. On April 15th, those who are 16 and older will be eligible.
